

Request for San Gorgonio Wilderness Day Hike "ONLY" PERMIT

Front Country Ranger District, San Bernardino National Forest

A Hiking Permit is required to enter the San Gorgonio Wilderness. Simple rules to protect you, the resources, and your wilderness enjoyment must be followed. Permits may be requested in person at the Mill Creek Ranger Station, Big Bear Discovery Center, or by mail or fax, up to 90 days in advance of your trip. There is a quota for each trail camp, so planning farther in advance increases the chance of your permit being approved. Please [check our business hours](#) and allow a **MINIMUM OF 5 BUSINESS DAYS** to process your wilderness permit. **Please complete the request ONLINE by typing directly onto the form.**

The following simple rules are to protect you, the resources, and your wilderness enjoyment. You are prohibited from:

1. A Wilderness Permit is recommended when entering or being in a National Forest Wilderness for Day Use.
2. As of 1998, **building, maintaining, or using an open campfire of any type including charcoal.** 36 CFR 261.52(a).
3. Use of trail, campsite, or other area in the San Gorgonio Wilderness by a group larger than 12 persons, or having more than 8 stock animals. 36 CFR 261.58.
4. Camping in a location other than that specified on the Permit. 36 CFR 261.10 (k) and 261.58 (e).
5. Camping or picketing stock within 200 ft of meadows, springs, streams, trails, or other occupied camps. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).
6. Camping or picketing stock within ¼ mile of Dollar Lake. 36 CFR 261.52 (e).
7. Camping within the same campsite in the South Fork drainage for more than two nights per party during any one trip into the Wilderness. 36 CFR 261.58 (e).
8. **Disposing of debris, garbage, or other waste material.** 36 CFR 261.57 (g).
9. Placing in or near a stream, lake, or any other body of water any substance that does or may pollute the water. 36 CFR 261.11 (c).
10. **Not having a shovel or hand trowel in possession for use in burying human waste during overnight camping or in cleaning sites for stove fires.** 36 CFR 261.58 (e) and 261.52 (g).
11. Shortcutting a switchback. 36 CFR 261.55 (d).
12. Mutilating, defacing, removing, disturbing, injuring, or destroying natural feature or property of the US Government. 36 CFR 261.9 (a).
13. Possessing or using a motor or motorized equipment except small battery powered handheld devices, such as cameras, shavers, flashlights, and Geiger counters. 36 CFR 261.16 (a).
14. Possessing or using any wheeled mechanical device including, but not limited to, bicycles, wagons, or carts. 36 CFR 261.57 (h).
Note: Use of wheelchairs by physically challenged persons is permitted.
15. Smoking except while seated in an area of at least 3 (three) feet in diameter that is barren or has been cleared of all flammable material. 36 CFR 261.52 (d).
16. **Possessing a dog not on a leash or otherwise confined.** 36 CFR 261.8 (d).

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than 6 (six) months, or both. 18USC36CFR1 Code of Federal Regulations
